In *Jet Black and the Ninja Wind*, multiple award-winning author, poet, and translator Leza Lowitz makes her first foray into young adult fiction with a compulsively readable tale whose teenage heroine must discover if she can put the blade above the heart—or die trying.

Leza Lowitz has published more than seventeen books, including *Yoga Heart*, *Beautiful Japan*, and *A Long Rainy Season*. Her numerous awards include the PEN/Oakland Josephine Miles Poetry Award, a PEN Syndicated Fiction Award, grants from the NEA and NEH, and the U.S.-Japan Friendship Commission Award from the Donald Keene Center at Columbia University. Her writing has appeared in the *Huffington Post*, *Shambhala Sun*, *Harpers*, and on NPR's "The Sound of Writing."

Shogo Oketani is a writer, journalist, and teacher of several martial arts, including karate, shaolinquan, kendo, and judo. Lowitz and Oketani live in Japan with their young son.







Fabrigami began as origami legend Florence Temko's final project. Sadly, Temko passed away before the book was completed, but her collaborator, Jill Stovall, continued their work. This book begins with instructions on how to treat fabric so it holds a shape when folded. Then Stovall shares a series of fun craft projects with simple origami-style diagrams that you can use to make a range of lovely objects, including:

Summer Rolls with Shrimp and Mint

These delicate herb-filled rolls are so delicious and healthy. They're great to have at parties because your friends can get into the act and make their own rolls (omit the shrimp for vegetarians). They may be called Summer Rolls but you'll want to enjoy them all year round. Rolls can be made several hours in advance and stored at room temperature in an airtight container lined with dampened paper towels.

I love to serve these rolls with a spicy soup like Ton Yum Gai for a fun girl's lunch high in flavor, but low in fat. The Hoisin Peanut Sauce (page 25) is divine and you'll want to double the recipe just to keep some on hand.

SERVE AS AN APPETIZER OR SNACK

PREPARATION TIME: 45 MINUTES

- 2 oz (50 g) dried rice vermicelli
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon dark sesame oil
- 16 medium-sized raw shrimp
- 1 package (12 in [30 cm]) round rice paper wrappers
- 1 cup (100 g) fresh bean sprouts, ends trimmed
- 1 cup (100 g) carrots cut into matchsticks
- 4 tablespoons fresh mint leaves
- 4 tablespoons fresh basil leaves
- 8 large or 16 small red-leaf lettuce leaves, cut in half lengthwise
- 4 tablespoons cracked roasted peanuts
- 4 tablespoons Hoisin Peanut Sauce (page 25)

- 1 Place the rice vermicelli in a large bowl. Pour enough hot water over them to cover. Let stand until softened, about 10 minutes. Drain and rinse with cool water. Toss with 1 teaspoon of sesame oil.
- 2 Add the shrimp to boiling water; reduce heat to medium. Cook shrimp until it turns pink, about 2–3 minutes. Drain, then cool, remove the shells. Cut each shrimp in half lengthwise, de-vein, and set aside.
- 3 Fill a large, flat bowl with warm water making sure it is large enough to fit the rice paper wrappers. Lay a clean towel on the workspace in front of you. Carefully dip a round wrapper into the water, just to get it wet all over, trying not to crack it. It will be slightly hard. Remove it from the water and lay it onto the clean towel, where it will continue to soften.
- 4 Layer a small amount of each of the ingredients on the bottom 1/3 of the wrap. Start with a lettuce leaf, then about 1 tablespoon of bean sprouts, then 2–3 pieces of shrimp, then some noodles, followed by some shreds of carrot, and then top with 2 leaves of basil and 2 leaves of mint. Fold up the bottom 1/3, fold in the sides and roll up the rest of the length to make an egg roll shape. Set aside and continue with the rest of the ingredients until all of the rice wrappers are used.

- 5 Cut rolls in half on a diagonal. Serve with Hoisin Peanut Sauce for dipping.



COOK'S NOTE: Make sure to use warm, not hot water, when soaking rice paper wrappers. I used to soak them hot too long and they'd fall apart. After lots of practice, I realized that the wrappers should still be slightly stiff so don't over-soak!



How to Assemble the Summer Rolls



1 After the shrimp is cooked, remove shells and cut each shrimp in half lengthwise and de-vein.



2 Measure the summer roll ingredients in individual bowls and place with the shrimp in preparation for rolling.



3 Layer a small amount of each of the ingredients on the bottom 1/3 of the wrap, fold up the bottom 1/3 tightly.



4 Fold in the left and right sides of the wrapper.



5 Continue rolling of the way to the top and press the seams closed to resemble an eggroll.

Reconnecting With Your Primal Gut in a Modern World

In *Bloom*, researcher and science writer Jeff Leach finds himself sitting around a campfire in a dry creek bed high in the rugged mountains of northern Namibia, wondering if the tribesmen on the other side of the fire, whom he had traveled 8,000 miles and to the farthest reaches of the world to find, held in their guts the microbial clues to some of the world's most devastating diseases.

Modern humans are 99.9 percent similar genetically, but the genetic content of the trillions of microbes living on and in our bodies, our microbiome, can differ by as much as 90 percent. Like a precious family heirloom, our initial population of bacteria is handed down to us from our mother during birth. This founding population soon outnumbers our own cells ten to one, making us more microbe than mammal—a veritable superorganism—and plays a critical role in our health throughout life. Just how critical is now being revealed by an explosion in powerful molecular techniques that are providing an unprecedented glimpse into the part microbes play in conditions as diverse as diabetes, cancer, obesity, autoimmune diseases, heart disease, and more.

In *Bloom*, Leach delves deep into our evolutionary past and traces forward the ecological, technological, and cultural events that have shaped the codevelopment of humans and our microbes. Modern lifestyle choices are dramatically impacting the health of our primal microbiome and, as a result, contributing to or causing many diseases. By looking backward to better understand the seasonal landscape that nurtured a normal—that is, healthy—microbiome, we just might find the clues to evolve ourselves into a better, disease-free future.

Jeff Leach is the founder of the Human Food Project. He has written for *The New York Times* and the *San Francisco Chronicle*, and his peer-reviewed research has been published in the *British Journal of Nutrition*, *European Journal of Clinical Nutrition*, *Bioscience and Microflora*, *Journal of Archaeological Science*, *Antiquity*, *Public Health Nutrition*, and many others. He is currently a gray-haired graduate student at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, where he is busy analyzing the microbial health of hunter-foragers and pastoralists of southern and eastern Africa and chimpanzee populations throughout Africa.



In Korea, life milestones have traditionally been celebrated with festivals and feasts. Such celebrations helped to define and honor an individual's identity. Based on a 2009 exhibition at the National Museum of Korea, the exhibition at the Asian Art Museum that *In Grand Style* documents incorporates new findings and researches. Co-organized by the Asian Art Museum and the NMK, the show—which opens in San Francisco in October 2013—presents rare and exquisite objects drawn from some ten museums in Korea. This is the first time that both the logic and profundity of Confucian theory has sprung so directly from the text.

Without the loss or addition of a single character *The New Analects* display an appearance that is utterly different from that of the past—the arguments are fresh, the themes coherent, the ideas clearly differentiated and the exposition lucid.

The author believes that Confucius, in his old age, was prevented from editing his sayings into a coherent whole because of the early death of his favorite pupil and that the *Analects* remained an unsorted collection of lecture notes. The author has reconstructed and rearranged the text thematically and distinguishes between what Confucius himself said and what his pupils said, *The New Analects* vividly illustrates the philosophical strands of thought that go to make up Confucianism as a whole.

Qian Ning graduated from the people's University of China with his B.A. and M.A. degrees on literature. He worked as a reporter for the *People's Daily* from 1986 to 1989 and was a Michigan Journalism Fellow (the University of Michigan) in 1989–1990. His most famous book is *Chinese Students Encounter America*, a bestseller in China.


